

Euthanasia Options & Pricing

At Pet Passages® of Largo we offer Euthanasia services along with Cremation. We have 2 options based on need and budget:

In Home Euthanasia with Truly Private Cremation

Pet Passages® schedules a vet to come to your home and provide the euthanasia service. Pet Passages® then maintains custody of your pet for cremation services through final return of remains.

Euthanasia at Pet Passages® with Truly Private Cremation

Pet Passages® is a funeral home for pets, not only a crematory. We have 3 Rainbow Bridge rooms designed for both intakes and euthanasia. These rooms are intended to provide the peaceful in-home like service versus a vet office - at a lower cost than in-home service. Your pet never leaves our funeral home for the cremation.

Both services offer Pet Parents a premium service at a reasonable price.

The Pet Passages® difference matters. Important things you should know:

At Pet Passages®, we DO NOT transfer your pet to anyone else for any service. We have our vet partners perform the euthanasia and then we provide the cremation service. This is vitally important for chain of custody.

Most other in-home service providers do not do the cremation service. Your pet is likely passed to a large high volume cremation company that you do not know. Your pet is also subject to being in a box freezer in someone's garage and not cremated for days. **You should be asking about the custody process**, including how it is managed and where your pet will go after the Vet takes your pet.

At Pet Passages®, we bring your pet right back to our funeral home or if you come to Pet Passages®, your pet never leaves our funeral home. You know where the care is provided and **you can tour our facility**. You can witness that the cremation is TRULY private. You have complete knowledge of your pet's chain of custody, **your pet is not frozen** and remains are ready for return within 2 days in most cases.

The **cremation package** included with our euthanasia services is our **Truly Private Remembrance Package**. This package includes:

- Engraved wood box urn with a velvet pouch
- Ink nose print
- Ink paw print
- Cremation certificate
- Blooming heart of remembrance

We also offer clay paw prints, urn upgrades, jewelry and keepsakes which can be viewed in our reception area or on our web site.

Our commitment is a 2 day turn around in most cases, excluding Sundays and holidays.

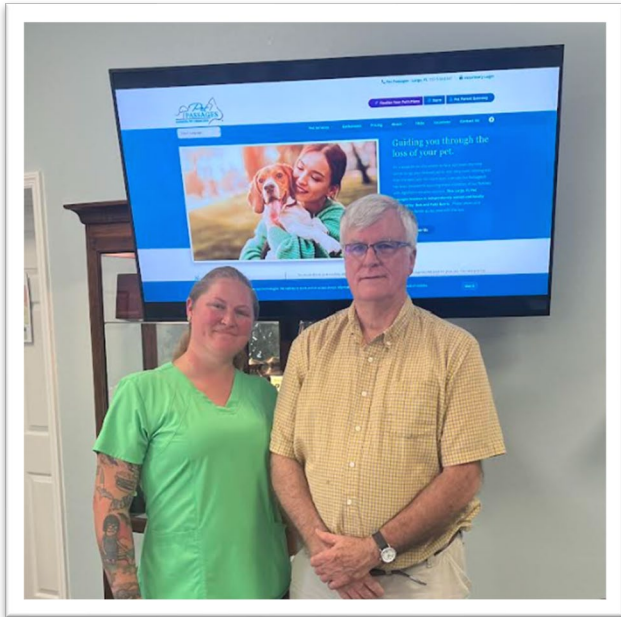
Please note:

- Appointments must be scheduled and same day may be available based on Vet availability. Emergency service may add up to \$100 depending on location and time of day.
- Pets must remain on leash at all times.
- Pets must remain on pads during and after euthanasia. A Pet Passages® funeral director will gently move your pet in order to manage any bowel or fluid release. Failure to comply with this could result in a \$100 cleaning fee. We will work with you to ensure you can say your final goodbye without incurring this fee.

- Availability could be limited for emergency situations, but we will work to accommodate you in your time of need.
- If Pet Passages® cannot schedule a vet, we can assist you with your needs via alternative emergency providers. This will generally be a vet office where we then provide the cremation services.

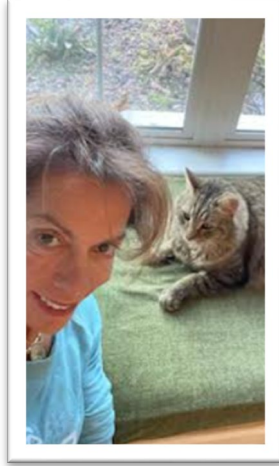
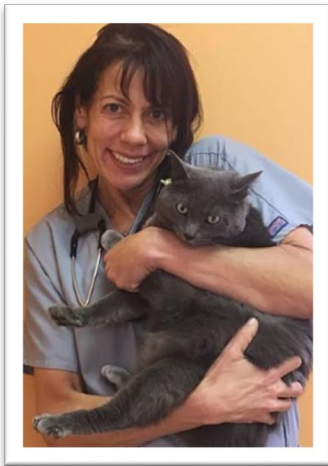


Dr. Donald S. Howell, DVM **Veterinarian**

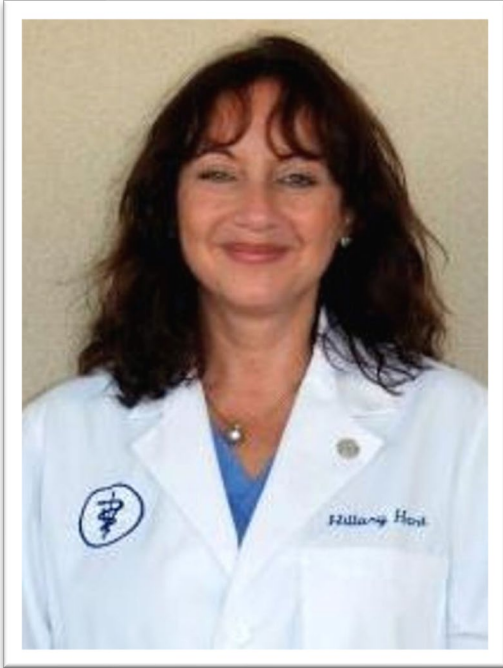
RaeAnne Vandebroek **Certified Veterinary Technician**
